2017 CHAMPIONSHIP LEGACY PROJECTS

MILITARY

PGA HOPE is the signature program of the Military pillar of PGA REACH. PGA HOPE is a therapeutic golf program designed to assist Military Veterans with their physical, social, and emotional well-being. The program is monitored under the guidance and instruction of PGA Professionals and has proven to connect Veterans together, provide an outlet for physical activity and competition, and support their assimilation back into the community. PGA HOPE's expansion across the Carolinas section over the last 12 months has been a result of the 2017 PGA Championship with an eye toward highlighting the program during this year's event. PGA HOPE currently has chapters being built in Charlotte, NC; Greensboro, NC; Charleston, SC; and Greenville, SC with more on the way in 2017. DIVERSITY INTERNSHIP

The PGA of America strives to be a leader in growing diversity in the game of golf with a focus on those who play the game, those who work in the game, and within our PGA Membership. With a concentration on increasing the diversity of those who work in golf administration, the PGA REACH Diversity Internship was created. The goal is to provide diverse youth that have a background in the game with valuable work experience in golf administration, ultimately creating a greater pipeline of diverse candidates for employment within the industry. THE CAROLINAS PGA REACH FOUNDATION

The Carolinas PGA REACH Foundation was founded in 2003 as a 501(C) 3 charitable organization to provide character building experiences to children of every race, creed, gender and socio-economic background. The foundation provides assistance to PGA Junior League Golf, the Drive, Chip & Putt Championship and numerous local junior events and tournaments. In addition to a focus on youth, the foundation has expanded to support diversity & inclusion and the military through the game of golf.

HOST SITE – QUAIL HOLLOW CLUB

The course was originally designed by famed golf course architect George Cobb in 1961 to capture the beauty as well as challenging terrain of the Piedmont region. In the intervening years, the course underwent a series of improvements, including modifications of several holes by Arnold Palmer in 1986, and a redesign by Tom Fazio in 1997, 2003 and 2016.

The Quail Hollow course has two signature holes. The par four, 14th is a dogleg left that can be driven with a good tee shot. It measures 346 yards from the championship tees. A 15 acre lake frames the left side of the hole and the rough on that side slopes down to the water. The narrow landing area measures about 27 yards across and is guarded with two bunkers on each side. The two tiered green is long and narrow with about 7,100 square feet of putting surface. Two more bunkers guard the left front and middle of the green, and a collection area waits just off the right front of the green for short approach shots hit off line, or almost perfect drives. The area immediately left of the green slopes severely down to the lake, so shots hit left have a very good chance of ending up in the hazard.

The 17th hole is a 221-yard par three over water. A rock wall rings this part of the lake and borders the left and front of the green. The tee shot must carry the water hazard, and a bunker that protects the center. The 6,500-square-foot green is undulated, and on the left side there is only six feet between the edge of the putting surface and water hazard. On the right lies a closely mown collection area for errant shots. The water will be the collection area on the left.
